6 Ways of Seeing

The Ways of Seeing show is CULT Gallery's annual platform for emerging talents. The way CULT chooses to curate these talents is unique - each artist presents a body of work (as opposed to a single work) that represents their art practices in entirety in their early career. A body of work opens up alternative perspectives to the audience as it can span a variety of media and techniques that the artist chooses to showcase a depth and breadth of visual narrative.

This year is the fourth year of Ways of Seeing featuring six artists—presenting sculptural works, Al generated prints, and paintings. This variety enriches and deepens Malaysia's art landscape, and is designed to showcase the diversity of creativity and thought processes that exist amongst our artists.



Aer, a 27-year-old artist, brings a unique perspective to the world of fine art. Having obtained a diploma in fine art in 2020 and participated in several art shows, Aer's journey has been marked by a commitment to exploring diverse mediums and themes.

Alexdrina Chons

Malaysian artist Alexdrina Chong's journey began in the US, teaching Visual Design before rising to senior designer in Chicago. Upon returning home, she founded So+Co, merging corporate branding with social advocacy. During Covid-19, she delved into introspection, resulting in her acclaimed book "100 Pages of Solitude" launched in 2023.

Her oeuvre, a mix of illustration, paintings and sculptures, showcases a unique richness often misconstrued by others, and at times by herself, as indecisiveness. As an illustrator, she intertwines prose and poetry to evoke emotion, while her fine art echoes abstract expressionism and surrealism manifested through her paintings and sculptural works. Delving beyond mere aesthetic exploration, Alexdrina's work serves as a conduit for the expression of her personal philosophy, anecdotal reflections, and rigorous self-examination.

Anissa Razali (b. 1994) graduated from Malaysian Institute of Arts (MIA), with a Diploma of Fine Arts in 2014. In 2017 she moved to Yogyakarta, Indonesia to study traditional dance under the Darmasiswa Scholarship. She continued her studies at Institut Seni Indonesia Yogyakarta (ISI) where she graduated with a Bachelor's in Kriya (Craft) in 2023.

She is fascinated by the idea of cultural expression in material and motion, and how these expressions are connected to land and metaphysics. Her ongoing endeavours involve exploring the ideas of ghosts in society from a socio-political and ecological lens. Previously she explored this idea in a series called Di Bawah Cahaya Bulan that was showcased in both Penang and Chiangmai, Thailand 2023. While in Chiang Mai she hosted a casual sharing session of ghost stories and reflections titled Girl, Ghosts and Us. Currently, she finds joy in working with inks, cyanotypes and metals.






